## **Senior/Disabled Property Tax Relief**

The Missouri Property Tax Credit (MO-PTC) Program, operated by the Missouri Department of Revenue, is the only program available this year.

This program enables qualified senior citizens or disabled persons to apply for a refund when filing the State income tax return or, if you are not required to file an income tax return, you may still be able to obtain a refund of real estate taxes through this program. The refund could be a full or partial amount of real estate taxes paid based on income level.

Income limitations are as follows:	Single	\$30,000 gross income
	Married	\$34,000 gross income
